Tennis Canada is pleased to announce the formation of a **New** Wheelchair Tennis Committee. The committee is a restructuring of the former Canadian Wheelchair Tennis Advisory Committee, and is being formed to better meet the needs of wheelchair tennis development, and to align with Tennis Canada's Strategic Plan.

The **New** Wheelchair Tennis Committee (WTC) consists of a panel of experts who act in an advisory and working capacity to further the growth and development of the sport. The WTC is aligned directly with the Core Business Areas of the Tennis Canada Strategic Plan, and additional areas that are specific to wheelchair tennis. The committee consists of the following positions:

Each committee position includes a specific job description and qualification requirements, which are outlined later in this document. Tennis Canada is accepting applications for these positions until April 15, 2005.
